Special Pandemic House Rules and Check-in Procedure

Updated November, 2020

- *Masks Must be Worn for All Guest Interactions
- *Use Hand Sanitizer Upon Entering the House (provided at entrance)
- *Follow Social Distancing Guidelines
- *Please help keep common areas clean

Special Pandemic Check-in Procedure

ADVANCE COMMUNICATION IS REQUIRED

Check-in must be coordinated, and a specific check-in time must be set prior to arrival to ensure that Covid-19 standards of cleanliness and sanitation are maintained. Failure to meet this requirement may result in cancellation.

Please follow social distancing guidelines inside the home. Masks must be worn during any interactions. Maintain a distance of six feet or more, to the extent possible, both for me and any other guests or residents. As the host and homeowner, I live and work from home, and spend most of my time at home. However, I minimize my use of common areas when guests are present. I do not wear a mask when alone, nor do I expect this of guests. However, I always have a mask at hand, ready to put on if a guest should appear. I request the same courtesy of guests. Please know that it is not my nature to be so distant, but that I do so out of caution and as a courtesy to you and other guests. Thank you very much for understanding!

Other House Rules

- * No Smoking of any kind on the premises
- * Quiet hours between 10pm - 8am
- * Please remove shoes inside the home
- * Please do not use hair dye, bleach or hair coloring products in the bedroom or bathroom
- * Legible profile photo (unobstructed headshot) required for reservation
